


About me...




Her Majersty's Printing Press (HMPP)


Prison sentences for first time knife carriers only push the offender further into criminality.

HMPP is a workshop idea that is designed for young offenders who want to break this cycle, it intends to offer lessons in creative practice to inspire where traditional methods may have failed.








Baldev (Brand Identity)



Logo process












Lob: A message that can be wrapped around a rubber crutch bottom and be thrown in large numbers.

For the brief I decided to focus on disability rights as it is an issue that I am passionate about and at the time of working on this project tensions were high around the implementation of new PIP legislation that saw disabled people having benefits seriously decreased and even revoked entirely.

I designed these T-Shirts for as Corona-virus restrictions were easing and more people were returning back to the business, this was part of the getting back on track campaign to help employees feel more confident about their safety in the workplace, with a dash of Sheffield dialect.

This was a good insight for me into project management as it was up to me and a couple of colleagues to find a local screen printer, collect the orders and then start distributing the shirts all over the UK. We managed to raise £2,000 For the NHS, Western Park Museum also asked to display the shirts in an exhibition.


Clava Face Mask (Applied Biomimicry)

Disposable surgical masks are the most popular type of face coverings used worldwide, as a result of this each month 129 Billion masks are used and disposed of.


These masks have a lifespan of 450 years before they Break-down into the environment and 75% end up in the worlds oceans. I decided to make a face mask from only natural materials that featured a living plant filter that could supply the wearer with oxygen whist also being a carbon negative product.

Onkalo Museum

In 2023 Europe's largest spent uranium storage facility with start being backfilled 500m below the earth in Finland they called it Onkalo which translates to the hiding place.

The brief initially was to create a warning to deter future visitors human or otherwise from complete planetary failure. Through my research I discovered offerings from scientific groups to tackle this issue including 10ft high spikes in the ground and concrete blocks enscribed with narratives of a demon living below the surface, I still believe human nature would prevail no matter how scary the landscape so for my response I decided to do the opposite and invite visitors in from around the world to see the ultimate dark tourist destination the Onkalo Museum and gift shop.
